# The cost is \$265 per team

If your team is staying <u>overnight</u> and you want us to take care of arrangements, there will also be a charge of \$15 per athlete. This fee will also include <u>one free room per team for coaches</u>. We will be staying on campus in one of the dorms. Fee includes bed and breakfast.

# **Equipment**

Teams must provide their own footballs. Players must bring their grass cleats, similar jerseys or t-shirts (2 different ones), and helmet with mouthpiece (if your state allows helmets).



## **Competition Rules:**

- 1. Teams may use seven (7) defenders and six (6) offensive players, plus a center. In Gun, use an extra player or coach to snap if you do not have a center.
- 2. Each possession begins on the +40 yard line. Winner of coin toss will have choice of possession to begin game.
- 3. First downs are made by crossing +25 and +10 yard lines.
- 4. Teams get three (3) downs to make a first down, even inside the +10 yard line.
- 5. QB has four (4) seconds to get pass off, or it will be a loss of down and the ball will be placed at the original line of scrimmage. If the ball leaves after 4 seconds, it cannot be completed to an offensive player, but it can be intercepted.
- 6. The four-second clock starts on the quarterback's first step or the snap of the ball in Gun.
- 7. Possession changes after a PAT try, failure to make a first down, or a turnover.
- 8. Games are two (2) 15 minute halves with a continuous running clock.
- 9. **All games will start on time**. There will be five (5) minute half-times and ten (10) minutes between games, but these segments will be shortened if needed to make sure the next games start on time.
- 10. 1 timeout per team per game. 1 minute long. If your team calls a timeout before time expires, there will be one more play.
- 11. All offensive formations must be legal sets.
- 12. The team has 25 seconds to get each play off. (Penalty = Loss of down).
- 13. Substitutions are free.
- 14. Games are one-hand touch, anywhere. After a catch, there is no downfield blocking.
- 15. No running plays are allowed. No laterals after reception. Ball is dead when it hits the ground (no fumbles).
- 16. Scoring: Touchdown = 6 points

PAT = 1 point from 3 yard line OR 2 points from 10 yard line (offense can select hash)

**Defensive Scores**: Turnover by INT (including PAT-attempt) **or** turnover on downs = 2 points (no runbacks after INT). Does not count as a "turnover on downs" if it is the last play of the half or game.

### 18. Pass Interference:

Defense: Automatic first down at the spot. If occurring in the end zone, ball is placed at the one yard line.

Offense: 5 yard penalty and loss of down (no team shall be backed up past the 40 yard line)

- 19. Helmets will be worn by all teams if their state allows. Teams playing opponents from states not allowing helmets will not wear helmets for that game.
- 20. Each team should bring two (2) different colors of jerseys or t-shirts in case of playing against a team with the same colors. Home team will have choice of jersey.
- 21. Any unnecessary roughness or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in a warning and a 10 yard penalty. A second offense will result in a 10 yard penalty and player ejection.
- 22. Overtime: NO OVERTIME in Pool Play. In Tournament, alternating possessions for PAT (3 or 10 yard line). Winner of coin flip gets choice of possession. 1<sup>st</sup> offense chooses their spot. Second team has the option of spots.
