Last Meeting

Southwest Baptist won 43-31 in Bolivar, Mo., on Sept. 13, 2008

Key Notes

- Harding is playing its last of three non-conference games to open the season.
- Harding junior running back Dominic Blood enters the game as the Bisons' leader in rushing and in receptions.
- Bison junior quarterback Josh Powell ranks second in the GSC with 298.5 passing yards per game.
- Entering the game, the Harding defense ranks third in the GSC with 190.5 passing yards allowed per game.
- This season marks Harding's ninth as a member of the Gulf South Conference. The Bisons are 37-41 in GSC action.
- Harding is under the direction of third-year head coach Ronnie Huckleba, who has a 8-13 overall record.
- The Bisons were picked to finish ninth in the 11-team Gulf South Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll. Harding senior wide receiver Kurt Adams was named to the Preseason All-GSC Team.

THE SERIES

- Harding and Southwest Baptist are meeting for the sixth time.
- Harding leads the series 4-1, winning the first four before losing last season.
- Harding has won both previous meetings in Searcy.
- The teams have scored 61 points or more in each of the last four games.
- Last season, Southwest Baptist won 43-31 in Bolivar. The Bearcats scored six rushing touchdowns.
- Harding ran a GSC-record 103 plays in last season's game and had 545 total yards. Ryan Ferrell kicked five field goals for the Bisons.

General Notes

- Harding is celebrating the 50th anniversary of the 1959 season. After a 28-year hiatus, Harding reinstated football in 1959. At halftime of the season opener, Harding recognized the members and coaches of the 1959 team. The team was coached by Carl Allison and went 1-5 with the lone win coming 7-6 over a team of Arkansas State freshmen.
- Ronnie Huckleba is in his third season as head coach at Harding. He has a 8-13 overall record. He is in his 24th season as a member of the Bison coaching staff.
- Harding's positional coaching assignments for the 2009 season are: Tim Perry (offensive coordinator/offensive line), Gray Yates (quarterbacks), Lee Edwards (wide receivers), Dr. Clay Beason (running backs/special teams), Paul Simmons (defensive line), Klay Bartee (linebackers) and Ronnie Huckleba (secondary).
- Graduate assistants for the 2009 season are Chris Binkley and Scott Symons. Neil Evans is the Bisons' student assistant.
- Harding captains for the 2009 season (voted on by the team) are: senior WR Cade Caton, senior OL Brad Parker, senior LB Jeremy Townsend, junior LB Jason Thomasson and senior LB Jermaine Blanchard. Additional members of the leadership council include: Josh Jones, Zac Ross, Eddie Russ, Jr., Jordan Watson, Kurt Adams, Luke Tribble, Alex Franklin and Keenan Kitchen.
- Today's game is the third of three non-conference games to open the season. The Bisons are 18-8 in non-conference games since joining the NCAA in 1997. Last season, Harding went 1-2 in non-conference games, defeating West Alabama.
- Harding will open its 10th season of Gulf South Conference play next Saturday at Delta State in Cleveland, Miss. Kickoff will be at 6 p.m.
- Today is Harding's second of six home games this season. It is the first time since 2004 that Harding will play six games at First Security Stadium. The Bisons are 32-14 (.696) at home since 2000.
- With its victory over Missouri Southern in the season opener, Harding improved to 13-10 against teams from the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association. HU is 1-1 vs. Central Missouri, 0-3 vs. Emporia State, 3-3 vs. Missouri Southern, 1-1 vs. Missouri Western, 4-1 vs. Southwest Baptist, 4-0 vs. Truman State and 0-1 vs. Washburn.
- Both Harding and its opponents have had 29 possessions through two games. The Bisons have scored four touchdowns, all through the air, and Bison opponents have scored six touchdowns, five through the air.
- Of the GSC teams who have played two games, Harding is averaging the fewest penalty yards per game at 46.0 ... the Bisons have 11 penalties for 92 yards through two games.

Offensive Notes

- Junior running back Dominic Blood is in the top 10 in two GSC statistical categories ... Blood ranks 10th in the conference in rushing with 43.0 yards per game ... on 21 carries this season, Blood has only been stopped for negative yardage once.
- Blood leads Harding with 10 receptions (55 yards) on the season, ranking sixth in the GSC with 5.00 receptions per game ... Blood has been the intended receiver on 10 passes and caught all 10.
- Junior quarterback Josh Powell ranks second in the GSC in passing yards per game (298.5), third in total yards (286.5) and fifth in passing efficiency (137.7) ... Powell's 70.3 completion percentage is tops among GSC quarterbacks ... he also leads GSC signal-callers in completions (64) and attempts (91) ... Powell is completing 77 percent (28-of-36) of his passes on first down.
- Senior all-purpose back Zac Ross is second on the team with nine receptions ... he ranks ninth in the GSC with 4.50 receptions per game ... six of Ross' nine catches have come on first down.
- Ross had 200 all-purpose yards against West Alabama (10 rushing, 19 receiving, 94 kickoff returns, 77 punt returns) ... it was his third career game with 200 or more all-purpose yards ... the two previous times were against Arkansas-Monticello (268 yards in 2007) and Arkansas Tech (220 in 2007).
- Ross ranks third at Harding in career receptions (123), second in receptions per game (5.35) and fifth in all-purpose yards (3,252) ... he needs 569 all-purpose yards to move past Santiago Collins (3,821, 2000-03) for fourth.

- Freshman Terrence Davis had seven catches for 92 yards and a seven-yard touchdown in his first career start at West Alabama ... he started in place of the injured Kurt Adams ... Davis ranks 10th in the GSC with 4.00 receptions per game.
- Senior center Brad Parker has led the Harding offensive line in post-game grades in both games this season ... he has been perfect on 145 shot-gun snaps.
- Powell completed 32 passes for 298 yards vs. Missouri Southern ... the 32 completions were the 10th-most by a Harding quarterback and the most ever by a Bison in his debut.
- Senior Kurt Adams was named First-Team D2Football.com Preseason All-America and First-Team Preseason All-GSC by both D2Football.com and the GSC coaches.
- Adams ranks second at Harding in receiving TD (22, three behind Gerald Payne), fourth in receiving yards (1,823, needs 764 yards to break Santiago Collins' school record), and sixth in receptions (113).
- Junior Jordan Watson has six receptions for 83 yards ... his 13.8 yards per catch leads the team ... Watson is tied for eighth in career TD receptions (11) and sixth in career receptions per game (3.87).

Defensive Notes

- Harding ranks third in the GSC in passing defense, allowing only 195.0 yards per game ... opponents have completed 68.8 percent of their passes but average only 6.1 yards per completion.
- Junior linebacker Jermaine Blanchard leads the GSC in tackles per game among players that have played in two games ... Blanchard has 19 tackles and averages 9.5 tackles per game ... Blanchard had 11 tackles, including 2.0 tackles for loss and blocked an extra point against West Alabama.
- Harding junior linebacker Jason Thomasson recovered two fumbles vs. Missouri Southern ... he was the only player in the GSC to recover two fumbles in the first week and became the first Harding player to have two fumble recoveries in a game since Travis DeSisso vs. Henderson State in 2004 ... Thomasson is Harding's leading returning tackler after making 89 stops last season.
- Harding's three active tackle leaders are Jason Thomasson (131), Jermaine Blanchard (130) and Jeremy Townsend (100).

Special Team Notes

- Harding ranks third in the GSC in kickoff returns with 23.1 yards per return ... five of the Bisons' nine kickoff returns have been for 20 yards or more (Zac Ross, 3; Eddie Russ, Jr., 2).
- Senior Zac Ross ranks third in the GSC with 29.0 yards per kickoff return ... Ross has five kickoff returns for 145 yards ... Ross is Harding's career leader with 1,600 kickoff return yards and 66 kickoff returns ... he averages 24.24 yards per kickoff return in his career, good for sixth all-time at Harding.
- Ross is sixth in the GSC with 13.3 yards per punt return (he leads all returners with more than five punt returns) ... he has seven returns for 93 yards ... Ross ranks fifth at Harding in career punt return yards (440) and seventh in punt returns (41) ... his 10.73 yards per punt return ranks seventh at Harding.
- Junior Eddie Russ, Jr. ranks seventh in the GSC with 21.0 yards per kickoff return ... he has three returns for 63 yards ... last season at Antelope Valley College, Russ returned six kickoffs for touchdowns.
- Junior Micah Canterbury is eighth in the GSC with 34.7 yards per punt ... he has a 48-yard long and has landed one inside the 20-yard line.
- Canterbury connected on both field goal attempts last week against West Alabama ... he made field goals from 40 and 36 yards.
- Junior Kyle Young is Harding's leading special team tackler with three on the season (two on kickoff returns and one on punt returns).

HEAD COACHING HIGHLIGHTS

After spending 21 seasons as an assistant coach at Harding, Ronnie Huckleba was named Harding's fifth head football coach in October 2007.

In 2008, Huckleba's squad had one of the nation's most potent offenses. Harding finished eighth nationally in total offense and second in passing offense. The Bisons compiled over 5,000 yards for the first time in school history.

In his first season as head coach, Huckleba's Bisons won five of their last six games to give Harding its fourth consecutive winning season.

COACHING HIGHLIGHTS

Huckleba served two years (2005-06) as offensive coordinator after spending the previous 11 seasons as the Bisons' defensive coordinator.

The 2009 season will mark Huckleba's 24th on the Harding sidelines. He has also served as secondary coach (1981-85), defensive front-seven coach (1988-93) and defensive coordinator (1994-2004).

In 2006, Huckleba directed one of the top offensive squads in the GSC, led by senior running back Kyle Wess, the GSC's rushing leader.

During his stint as a Harding defensive coach, Huckleba coached 30 All-Conference performers and 11 All-America honorees, including Tim Polk in 2003.

Huckleba began his collegiate coaching career at Harding as the secondary coach in 1986, moving to the defensive front seven in 1988 and to defensive coordinator in 1994.

Prior to coming to Harding, Huckleba spent five seasons as the head coach at Ouachita Christian where he was named the Louisiana Class A Coach of the Year in 1985 after leading OCS to a 15-0 record and state championship.

In 1979, Huckleba began his coaching career as an assistant at Carlisle High School in Carlisle, Ark. The next year he moved on to Fort Worth Christian School in Fort Worth, Texas where he served as an assistant under Randy Tribble, winning the TAPPS state championship.

PLAYING CAREER

Huckleba was a standout Bison offensive lineman for Harding from 1973-76. He started at guard on the Bisons' 1976 Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference co-championship squad.

Huckleba was a three-year letterwinner, playing both tight end and defensive end at Claxton High School in Claxton, Ga., from 1969-72.

EDUCATION

Huckleba received his bachelor's degree in education from Harding in 1978. He earned his master's degree in physical education from Harding in 1983.

PERSONAL

Huckleba is a native of Claxton, Ga., and is an Assistant Professor of Kinesiology.

He is married to the former Peggy Jones of Schreveport, La. The couple has three children: Hope, Jeb, and Jordan.

Huckleba's oldest son, Jeb, was a fifth-round pick by the Seattle Seahawks in the 2005 NFL Draft after completing a four-year career as a defensive end at the University of Arkansas. Jordan earned Academic All-District honors as a Bison defensive back.



BY THE NUMBERS...

232 Number of games Harding has played since Ronnie Huckleba joined the Bison coaching staff in 1986 as the secondary coach.

21 Seasons Huckleba spent as an assistant coach at Harding before being named interim head coach Sept. 11, 2007. Huckleba had previously served as offensive coordinator, defensive coordinator, defensive front seven coach and secondary coach.

1976 Year Huckleba was a starter at guard and Harding won its second Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference championship in five years.
